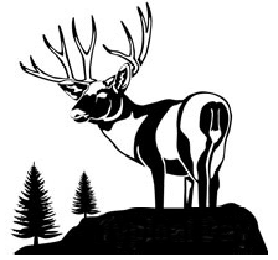




# Flagstaff Archers

## *MEMBERSHIP APPLICATION*

Flagstaff Archers is a non-profit club whose purpose is to promote archery and bow hunting in Northern Arizona. The club maintains an archery range at Fort Tuthill that is open to members year-round. The range is located approximately ½ mile southerly of the Luke Air Force Base Recreation area. At the range, there are practice targets with excelsior bales at distances of 10 to 70 yards, a 15 target walk through course with McKenzie 3-D targets and a Ramada with picnic tables.

Flagstaff Archers hosts various events throughout the year, including the Archery Special Olympics, beginner clinics, club shoots, leagues, and 3-D open shoots. We also help with Arizona Bowhunter Association events, and help the Game and Fish Department. Club members are relied upon to help maintain the range and host the various activities and shoots. Being active and involved is a great way to meet other members with similar interests and exchange help about archery and bow hunting. As an incentive to help, credit is given for each ½ day you help at the range or a shoot. This credit is applied to the next years dues.
